



IDAHO MOUNTED ORIENTEERING MURPHY RIM RIDE JUNE 9, 2007



*A timed, competitive equine sport that combines riding,
map reading, compass use, direction-finding skills
and clues to find five hidden plates.*

Preparing for hot/dry or wet/windy weather, this ride will only be about 10 miles long (5.5 miles for the short course). Ride along the Oregon Trail; experience it as the pioneers did—on horseback. Come enjoy a short ride with beautiful views of Idaho's mountains, rocky buttes, and the river valley.

RIDE DUES:

NEED TO BRING:

Something for the after-ride potluck
(Spaghetti will be provided by the Ride Managers)
A chair if you wish to sit
Compass with 2° increments; pen or pencil
Water for your steed and yourself (dry camp)
A trusty steed at least 3 years old

DIRECTIONS:

From I84 – Garrity/Nampa Exit 38, head South on Garrity to 16th Ave. N. (Lakeview Park, Jet); Turn left on 16th. Turn Right on 7th St. S. Turn Left on 12th Ave. S. (Hwy 45). Continue on 12th/Hwy 45 through Nampa, cross the Snake River. Stay to left at the Junction of Hwy 45 & Hwy 78. Travel on Hwy 78 to Murphy (about 10 miles). Just before crossing the Rabbit Creek bridge and entering Murphy, turn Left (north) on Con Shea Basin Rd.; 1 mi. to camp.

From Mountain Home – Go to Grandview. Turn West on Hwy 78. Travel to Murphy. Just on the North side of the Rabbit Creek bridge (North edge of Murphy), Turn Right on Con Shea Basin Rd.
