

Idaho Mounted Orienteering

Big Jacks Creek Ride

May 31, 2008

A timed, competitive equine sport that combines riding, map reading, compass use, direction-finding skills and clues to find five hidden plates.

This ride will be about 15 miles long (5 miles for the short course). The trails are rocky in places, so shoes for the horses are recommended.

REGISTRATION: Friday, 5/30: 6:00 PM to 9:00 PM
Saturday, 5/31: 6:30 AM to 11:00 AM
Riders out in 15-minute intervals starting at 7:00 AM

RIDE DUES: Daily Membership: \$15
Annual Members: \$12
All Riders 16 & under: \$5

NEED TO BRING: Something for the after-ride potluck
(Main course will be provided by the Ride Managers)
A chair for sitting
Compass with 2° increments
Pen or Pencil
Water for your steed and yourself
A trusty steed at least three years old

DIRECTIONS: From Boise area, take Hwy 84 to Simco exit. Turn right at stop sign at the end of the off-ramp. Travel south on Simco Road to the end where it intersects Grandview Rd. Turn right, follow the main road through Grandview until it intersects Hwy 78. Turn left at the gas station onto Hwy 78. Travel to the intersection of Hwy 78 and Hwy 51 (before Bruneau).

From Mountain Home, take Hwy 51 through Bruneau to the point where Hwy 78 splits off of Hwy 51 west of Bruneau.

From the intersection of Hwy 51 and Hwy 78, go south on Hwy 51 for 16.3 miles, just past Mile Marker 54. Turn right on the gravel road a couple hundred yards past MM 54. Continue on the gravel road for about 2.5 miles to camp.
