

IMO Slaughterhouse Gulch, July 12, 2008

<b>1</b>	28° From a small flagged juniper E of HQ
<b>Hi</b>	94° From a stack of rocks on the E side of the road running through camp
<b>2</b>	310° From a pile of rocks on a large rock on the E end of the dam 330° From a flagged juniper on the W end of the dam
<b>3</b>	106° From a man-made pile of rocks beside the road 214° From the center tree of a group of three choke cherry trees E of the road (flagged)
<b>4</b>	158° From a green steel T-post in the meadow E of the road 70° From a flagged juniper tree E of the road
<b>5</b>	40° From a burned stump with a pile of grayish rocks on it 150° From a pile of small river rocks in the S junction of the roads
<b>A</b>	298° From a stump with rocks on it beside the road 218° From a pile of rocks at the base of a small juniper tree beside the road
<b>B</b>	312° From the NE corner (rocks piled in a wire cage) of the cemetery 338° From a flagged wooden fence post in the fence on the N side of the cemetery

Notes:

We are sorry, but there are two gates on this ride. Please close them after you go through.

Cattle are present throughout the whole ride. Don't bother or chase them.

We couldn't find the little spur road that the map shows going to the knob below #3—watch topography! All the roads, otherwise, shown on the map are there. We didn't find many roads or trails that are not shown on the map, and relied on the GPS unit to draw in the 4WD trail between A and camp.
