



Idaho Mounted Orienteering Dry Buck Ride

*A timed, competitive equine sport that combines riding,
map reading, compass use, direction-finding skills
and clues to find five hidden plates*

This ride will be about 12 miles long (4 miles for the short course).

REGISTRATION: Friday, ~~6/12~~ 6/26: 6:00 PM to 9:00 PM
Saturday, ~~6/13~~ 6/27: 6:30 AM to 11:00 AM
Riders out in 15-minute intervals starting at 7:30 AM

RIDE DUES: Daily Membership: \$15
Annual Members: \$12
All Riders 17 & under: \$5

NEED TO BRING: Something for the after-ride potluck
(Main course will be provided by the Ride Managers)
A chair for sitting
Compass with 2° increments
Pen or Pencil
Water for yourself (There is a creek near camp for horse water, if needed)
A trusty steed at least three years old

DIRECTIONS: There are several routes that go to camp. Two are listed here:

Through Horseshoe Bend and Gardena: Take Hwy 55 about five miles past Horseshoe Bend. Turn left at Gardena onto Brownlee Road, cross the river, the road turns right, and stay on Brownlee Road 5.1 miles. Go straight on Cutoff Road, continue on Cutoff Road 1.2 miles to "T." Turn right on Dry Buck Road, stay on Dry Buck Road for 6.2 miles to the Pinehurst Church on the left. Just past the church, turn right on Banks Grade Road (there is no sign), and go about 0.3 miles to camp.

From Emmett: Take Hwy 52 east, then turn north on the Sweet-Ola highway for 2.6 miles and turn right on Kirkpatrick Road. Continue on paved road that becomes Brownlee-Liberty Rd. After 2.5 miles, go left on Dry Buck Road (Brownlee-E.Cemetary Rd. is straight) and continue 6.5 miles to the Pinehurst Church. Turn right on Banks Road across from the church. Continue 0.3 miles to camp.
