A timed, competitive equine sport that combines riding, map reading, compass use, and clues to find five hidden plates.

We are proud to have this 12-mile ride in one of the most geologically unique areas of Idaho. Come ride with us and see this ancient lakebed with its beautiful spring flowers, scenic hill-top views, and spectacular canyons. Enjoy friendly competition or just have a wonderful trail ride on the 6-mile short course. The footing is mostly sandy with some rocky areas.

Riders out in 15-minute intervals starting at 7:00 a.m.

RIDE DUES: Daily Membership - \$15
Annual Members - \$12
All Riders 17 & under (as of 1/1/10) - \$5

NEED TO BRING: Something for the after-ride potluck luncheon
(Grilled sausages & fixings will be provided by the Ride Managers)
A chair if you wish to sit
Compass with 2° increments; pen or pencil to mark the map
Water for your steed and yourself (dry camp)
Certified noxious-weed-free feed for steed
A trusty steed at least 3 years old

DIRECTIONS: Take Hwy 51 south from Mountain Home to Bruneau. Turn left (SE) at the Bruneau One Stop onto Hot Springs Rd. Go approximately 8 miles to ? road (there isn't a road sign, so look for IMO sign). Turn right and cross the Bruneau River on a concrete bridge. Go almost 3 miles and take the fork to the left. Go about 1 mile, turn left onto a dirt track. Camp is in a disked-up area about 300 yards up this track. Lots of parking!
