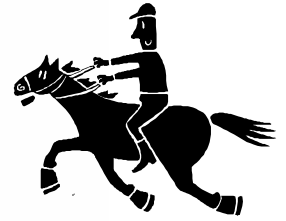

REGISTRATION:

Riders out in 15-minute intervals starting at 7:00 a.m.

RIDE DUES:

Daily Membership - \$15 Annual Members - \$12
All Riders 17 & under (as of 1/1/10) - \$5

NEED TO BRING:

A Trusty steed at least 3 yrs. old
A compass with 2° increments & pen or pencil to mark the map
Water for you and your steed (there is some water in the creek)
Certified noxious-weed-free feed for steed
Something for the after-ride potluck and a chair if you wish to sit

DIRECTIONS:

From I84: Take Exit 46 (Eagle Rd/Hwy 55); go N about 6.5 mi. to Hwy 44; turn Right. Travel E 1.8 mi to Hwy 55: turn Left. Travel N on Hwy 55 to Banks. Turn Right on the Crouch/Lowman road. Travel east through Garden Valley. About 1 mile east of Garden Valley, turn Right toward Placerville on Alder Creek Rd. (FS Rd 615); cross the Payette River and turn Left on South Fork Rd. (1st road to left). Travel east about 1/2 mile to Wash Creek Rd. Turn Right on Wash Creek Rd. into ride site.

PARKING WILL BE TIGHT! THERE IS LIMITED ROOM TO SET UP PORTABLE CORRALS. PLEASE BE CONSIDERATE AND TRY TO PARK AS THRIFTILY AS POSSIBLE. If you are a GOOD backer, there is more parking just a little further up the road off River Run Way (private drive, but is access to FS land) with lots of room , even for portable corrals, but you have to back into a spot to turn around. **NO ROOM TO JUST WHEEL AROUND IN A CIRCLE.** Look First.
