This is an alternative site, originally billed as the “Presidents Trail Ride.” The ride had to be moved due to trail closures around the Deer Park forest fire, which is still burning.

Still a beautiful place in the forest to ride and camp.

REGISTRATION:

Friday evening or Saturday morning.

Riders out in 15-minute intervals starting at 7:30 a.m.

RIDE DUES:

Annual Members: \$12

Daily Membership: \$15

All Riders 17 & under (as of 1/1/10): \$5

WHAT TO BRING:

A steed at least 3 years old

A compass with 2° increments & pen or pencil to mark the map

A side dish for the potluck

A chair and water/beverage for yourself

(There is water in the creek for steeds)

Certified noxious-weed-free hay

DIRECTIONS:

I84 to Mountain Home. Take Exit 95 (Sun Valley Hwy); turn Left (North) on Hwy 20. Travel North on Hwy 20 about 21 miles to Anderson Dam Rd.; turn Left. Cross the Dam and turn Right on South Fork Rd. (FS Rd. 113). Travel along the reservoir about 8 miles (go past Fall Creek marina). Turn to Left on Fall Creek Rd. (FS Rd. 123) (sign says Ice Springs). Travel about 1.3 mi. to Camp on right. Watch for IMO signs as mileage is approximate. Lots of parking; good camping; water in the creek.
