Sweet / Dry Buck Ride

September 18, 2010

From Horseshoe Bend / Gardena: Take Hwy 55 about five miles past Horseshoe Bend. Turn left at Gardena onto Brownlee Road, cross the river, the road turns right, and stay on Brownlee Road 5.1 miles. Go straight on Cutoff Road, continue on Cutoff Road 1.2 miles to "T." Turn right on Dry Buck Road, go about 6.2 miles to the Pinehurst Church on the left. Just past the church, turn Right on F.S #643, continue 0.3 miles to camp.

From Emmett: Take Hwy 52 east, turn north on the Sweet-Ola highway for 2.6 miles and turn right on Kirkpatrick Road. Continue on paved road that becomes Brownlee-Liberty Rd Go 4.5 miles, stay left on Dry Buck Road (Brownlee-E. Cemetery Rd. is straight) and continue 7.5 miles to the Pinehurst Church. Just past the church, turn Right on F.S #643, continue 0.3 miles to camp.

Riders out in 15 Minute intervals from 7:00 until 11:00 AM

What to bring:

1. Mount at least 3 years old - in good condition
2. Camp will have water for you mounts
3. Compass (2 degree preferred)
4. Side dish (salad, desert, etc)
5. Chair(s) are a good idea

Weed Free hay or equivalent is required
Hay and manure needs to be scatted before leaving
