### DIRECTIONS

Take Hwy 51 south from Mountain Home to Bruneau. Turn LEFT (SE) at the Bruneau One Stop onto Hot Springs Rd. Go almost 8 miles to “?” Rd (no street sign, look for IMO sign). Turn right and cross the Bruneau River on the concrete bridge. Stay on this road almost 3 miles, then take the fork to the left. Go west about 2 miles to camp. Lots of parking.
