PLEASE BRING

Something for the after-ride potluck
(main Meat will be provided)
Trusty Steed at least 3 years old
Compass with 2-degree increments
Pen or Pencil to mark the map
Certified noxious-weed-free feed for steeds
Water for your steed and yourself
A chair if you wish to sit

DIRECTIONS: From Nampa—12th Avenue Rd/Hwy 45 south to Hwy 78. Stay to the left at the Y. Travel southeast to about milepost 43. From Grandview—Travel northwest on Hwy 78 to about milepost 43. Turn south to **Oreana**. Travel about 2.2 miles and at the Old Rock Church, turn right (west) on Bachman Rd. Travel west then southwest until you top out at Toy Pass. After the Toy Pass sign, go about 4 miles more and turn right (west) at the IMO sign. Stay on this road until you come to camp.
