DIRECTIONS

From Nampa: Take 12th Ave Rd/Hwy 45 South. At the Hwy 45/Hwy 78 Junction, stay to left toward Murphy. Travel south about 3/10 mile; turn right on the Hemingway Butte-Reynolds Watershed road [Upper Reynolds Creek Rd] (no street sign, but is 1st road after the junction). Travel about 14 miles to the Reynolds cemetery.

From Grandview: Take Hwy 78 to Murphy. Just north of the Rabbit Creek Bridge (in Murphy), turn left on Rabbit Creek Rd (becomes Reynolds Stage Rd). Stay on this road almost 12 miles to the Reynolds cemetery. Turn Left.

From the Reynolds Cemetery: Travel S 1/4 mi.; turn Right. Travel W 1 mi.; turn Left. Go about 1/10 mi., pass the first road (a driveway); turn Right. Travel uphill on this winding gravel road about 2.3 miles (large semi cattle trucks can do it!). At the top, turn Right at the first junction. Travel W about 1.3 mi. to camp at the corrals.
