

Idaho Mounted Orienteering Little Jacks Creek Ride May 30, 2015

map reading, compass use, direction-finding skills,
and clues to find five hidden plates*

REGISTRATION: Saturday, 5/30: 7:30 AM to 11:00 AM
Riders out in 15-minute intervals starting at 7:30 AM

RIDE DUES: Daily Membership: \$20
Annual Members: \$15
All Riders 17 & under: \$5

NEED TO BRING: Something for the after-ride potluck
(The main course will be provided by the Ride Managers)
A chair for sitting
Compass with 2° increments
Pen or Pencil
Water for yourself and your steed
A trusty steed at least three years old

DIRECTIONS: From Murphy:
Take Highway 78 to the Grandview Road intersection. Go 2.2 miles to split in road. Take right fork onto Mud Flat Road (aka Back Country Byway), go for 7.7 miles. Then turn left on Shoo Fly Cutoff Road, and go another 4.5 miles to camp.

From Bruneau:
Take Hwy 78 to 51. Go south on Hwy 51 just past MM 64. Turn right on Shoofly Road (across the highway from Sugar Valley Road). Go 5.4 miles to camp.

NOTES: Sections of the trails are rocky. Consider shoes or other hoof protection.
