DIRECTIONS

<u>From Emmett</u>: Turn N off Hwy 16 onto Hwy 52. Stay on Hwy 52 to Triangle (13.5 mi).

Turn N on Sweet-Ola Hwy.

From Horseshoe Bend: Turn W off Hwy 55 onto Hwy 52; go to Triangle (9.5 mi).

Turn N on Sweet Ola Hwy. Travel N about 17.4 mi (just past Ola) to FS Rd 644 (aka NF-766 & High Valley Rd).

TURN E: travel E then S to the next junction (5 mi). Turn W to camp (about .5 mi).
