A timed competitive equine sport that combines riding with map reading, compass use, and clues to find five hidden markers.



DIRECTIONS: From I84, take Mountain Home exit 90. Take the first left and go east on Frontage Road 2 miles to stop sign. Turn left, go north 7.2 miles. Right on Immigrant Road, go east 3 miles. Camp is on right, south of the road.

TO BRING:

A mount at least 3 yrs old	Water for horses
Compass with 2° increments	Pen or Pencil to mark the map
A dish for the pot luck	People drinks
Hat/sun screen/bug spray	A lawn chair
