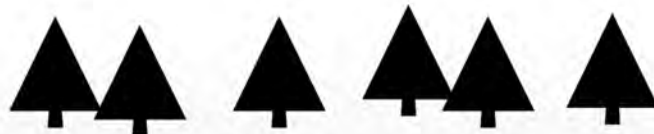

**DIRECTIONS** -- Take Hwy 52 east from Emmett, or west from Horseshoe Bend, to Triangle Junction. Turn N on Sweet/Ola Hwy. Travel about 28 mi N to FS Road 626. Turn Right (E); travel about 6 mi to camp near the junction of 626 & 685. **ANOTHER WAY:** Hwy 55 to Smiths Ferry; turn left (W) on FS Rd 626 at Cougar Mountain Lodge. Travel NNW on 626 about 11 miles to camp (this road is narrow, twisty & bumpy). Camp and No. 1 will be at one of three sites near this junction; two sites N of 626 and one S of 626 on 644. Signs will be posted. This area is a popular camping site.
