DIRECTIONS

From Grandview: From the Hwy 78/Hwy 167 junction, take Hwy 78 ESE 2.1 miles to the Bruneau/Mud Flat Road junction. Take Mud Flat Road 18.1 miles to the Oreana Loop Cutoff Road (aka Poison Creek Cutoff). Turn N on Oreana Cutoff Road; go N 4.3 miles to an unnamed gravel road. Turn W on the gravel road; go 1.3 miles to camp.
