DIRECTIONS

Turn off Hwy 78 onto Oreana Loop Rd. to the S,SW [about 29.8 miles from the junction of Hwy 45 & Hwy 78; or 14.5 miles from the junction of Hwy 167 & Hwy 78 in Grandview]. Travel about 4.1 miles to Poison Creek Cutoff Rd. (aka: Castle Creek Cutoff, Oreana Loop Cutoff) Turn LEFT (S,SE). Travel ???.? Miles to Camp
