### **DIRECTIONS:**

From I-84, take exit 90. Take an immediate left (East) onto Frontage Road. Drive approx. 2 miles to the T-stop. Turn left (North) on to Canyon Creek Road and continue over the interstate to the 4-way stop. Go straight,12 miles till you reach the cattle guard at the base of Danskin Lookout Road (FS Road 167) Camp is 1.4 mi. up the road (BEFORE that big climb) Management will be there to post IMO signs Friday evening NTL than 4:30 pm.

## **RIDE DUES:**

Adult members \$15 Adult nonmembers \$20 All riders 17 and younger will be \$5

#### TO BRING:

A steed at least three years old. People and horse water Hat/sun screen ,Compass with 2° increments, Lawn chair , Pen or Pencil to mark the Map. , A potluck dish to share, management will provide a main dish

**Note:** No horse water in camp, but there is water on the trail.

Sandy soil with a few rocks. Shoes at your discretion
