

IDAHO MOUNTED ORIENTEERING

HUNTER CREEK RIDE

August 18, 2018

At Deer Park, NE of Idaho City, on the North Fork of the Boise River



WHAT YOU WILL NEED

A trusty steed at least 3 years old Certified noxious-weed-free feed Compass with 1 or 2-degree increments Pen or Pencil to mark the map Dish to share at after-ride potluck lunch (Hot dogs & fixings will be provided) Rider beverages of choice Chair if you wish to sit

DIRECTIONS

From Idaho City, take Hwy 21 for 18 miles to Crooked River/Little Owl Road #384 (Edna Camp Ground). Turn right and stay on #384 for 13.5 miles to North Fork Boise River Rd. #327. Turn left on #327 and drive upstream for 5 miles to Hunter Creek Rd. #348. Go straight ahead on #348 about 1/4 mile to a Y (#348 to left, #348A to right). The main parking is at the east end of Rd. #348A. Staging and lunch will be at the junction of 348A and the driveway to the cabin. There is more camping at the Y on both sides of Rd. 348. This is a popular camping area; come early if you can. (*Conservative parking is requested: back into a spot and put portable pens outside the flat parking in the grassy areas;* don't park in the middle of the road where people need to turn around; etc.) Using map, compass and clues, find five preplaced plates while riding your equine partner. The ride is about 15 miles long on forest trails and old logging roads.
