

**Idaho Mounted Orienteering
Rivers Edge IMO
May 4, 2019**



A timed equine sport that combines riding with map reading, compass use, and clues to find five markers.

DIRECTIONS:

From I-84 take exit 90. Go through Mountain Home to Idaho Hwy 51. Turn South onto Hwy 51 (Towards Bruneau). Go approx 11 miles to Gravel Pit Road. Turn West and go approx 2.4 miles to flagged road (just before fence & cattle guard) turn left and into camp. Camp is on rim overlooking the Snake River. Plenty of parking but watch for rocks. Gravel Pit Road, and camp will be signed.

RIDE DUES:

Adult Annual Members: \$15, Adult Day Members: \$20, All Members 17 years old and under: \$5

TO BRING:

A steed at least three years old. People and horse water. Bug repellent and hat/sun screen, Compass with 2° increments. Lawn chair, Pen or Pencil to mark the map. Maybe a fishing pole.

A potluck dish to share, management will provide a main dish.

Note: No horse water in camp. Ride is on varied terrain. Shoes recommended.
Length approximately 14 miles.
