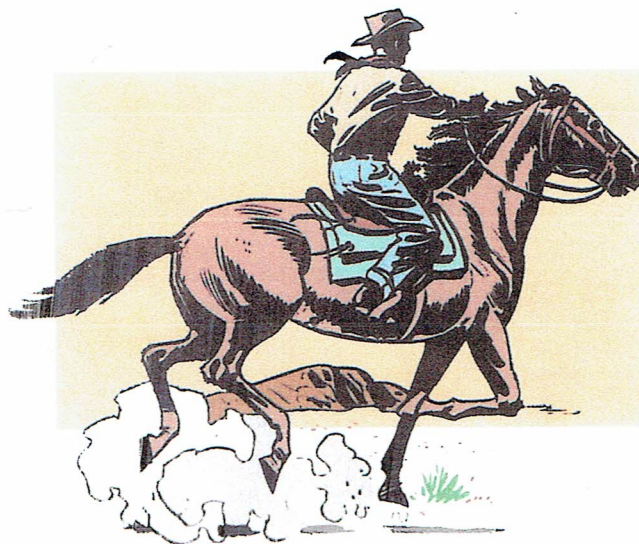

DIRECTIONS: TAKE EXIT 95 OFF I-84 AT MOUNTAIN HOME. GO EAST
TOWARD SUN VALLEY ON HIWAY 20 FOR 7.2 MILES TO TEAPOT ROAD
(.5 MILE BEOND MILE MARKER 102) TURN RIGHT (SOUTH) AND GO 2
MILES TO CAMP.
