Ride Dues:

\$5.00 for all participants under 17 years of age

What to Bring:

1. Trusty steed at least 3 years old – in good condition
2. Water and / or Beverages for you and your Steeds (Certified weed-free hay)
3. Compass (2 degree) / Pen or Pencil
4. Potluck contribution for lunch – Side dish (salad, desert, etc).
Main dish will be provided.
5. Chair(s) are a good idea
6. Rake and shovel to clean up hay and manure before leaving
7. **Mosquito / Fly spray for you and your horse**

The ride is on varied and rocky terrain with some water crossings. Shoes or boots are recommended.

Directions: Take Highway 21 to Idaho City. In Idaho City, turn left on Montgomery St., then left on FS Rd. 307 to Placerville (14mi). In Placerville, at the stop sign in front of the fire station, turn right and go .2 miles to Old Centerville Rd. (The road sign is set back from the road, so look for the IMO Signs). Turn right on Old Centerville Rd. and go .9 miles to turn left on 386, Ophir Creek Road, then 1.3 miles to camp. From Horseshoe Bend (Hwy 55), Take Harris Creek Rd. to Placerville.
