
IDAHO MOUNTED ORIENTEERING

FIRST RIDERS OUT @ 7:00 AM -RIDERS OUT IN 15 MINUTE INTERVALS

Directions: From Boise I-84 to Hwy 95 -- Fruitland Exit 3.

North on Hwy 95 to Weiser.

At stop-light in Weiser, turn "R" on "PARK RD" Note: This road turns into WEISER RIVER RD. 11 miles to "Y" -- stay "R" -- BEAR CREEK RD. 2.3 miles to SOUTH CRANE RD, stay "L".

13.4 miles to junction, stay "R" -- BIG FLAT ROAD sign.

2.8 miles, turn "L". go .5 to "T", turn "L".

1.3 miles to "Emmet-Ola-Sweet" sign—turn "R".

1 mile to the "Gravel Pit" area.

WATER FOR YOU AND YOUR STEED - NO WATER IN CAMP

WEED FREE HAY - SHOVEL OR FORK TO SPREAD MANURE & HAY

2-DEGREE COMPASS / PENCIL OR PEN / CHAIR

SOMETHING FOR POT LUCK

THE RIDE IS ON VARIED AND ROCKY TERRAIN. SHOES / BOOTS ARE RECOMMENDED.
