An equine sport that combines riding with map reading \& a compass to find five hidden plates on a trail

The ride will be approx. 14 miles long. Camping space available.


#### Abstract

Directions: From Boise: Head north on Hwy 55. About 5 miles past Horseshoe Bend, turn left at Gardena onto Brownlee Rd. crossing the river and then turn right for about .5 mile before you take a left to stay on Brownlee Rd. Follow for about 5 miles and go straight onto Cutoff Rd. Follow for a mile and turn right onto Dry Buck Rd. Follow about 6.2 miles and just past the little country church (Pinehurst Church) that sits on the left, take a right onto FS 643 and .3 miles to camp. Watch for signs.


From Emmett: Head east on Hwy 52, take left/north onto Sweet-Ola Hwy by the Triangle Dinner House. Follow for about 2.5 miles, take right onto Kirkpatrick Rd. Follow 2 miles to the " $Y$ " in the road (pavement ends), go right onto Brownlee Rd. Follow 2.5 miles and take left at " $Y$ " onto Dry Buck Rd. Follow about 7.6 miles and just past the little country church (Pinehurst Church) that sits on the left, take a right onto FS 643 and . 3 miles to camp. Watch for signs.

Registration: 7-9 pm Friday, 6:30-11:30 Saturday. Riders/teams out Starting at 8:00 AM and then every 15 minutes. Last riders out at 12:00.
