



**Idaho Mounted Orienteering
Down, Up, and Around Ride
September 12, 2020**

A timed equine sport that combines riding with map reading, compass use, and clues to find five markers.

DIRECTIONS:

From I-84, take exit 90. Turn left/east onto the Frontage Road, follow approx. 2mi to the stop sign. Turn left/north on Canyon Creek road, and follow till it turns left/west onto the Foothills Rd. Continue to the junction of Foothills/Slater Creek/Mayfield Rd. Go north up the hill on NF 167. There is a short part that is fairly steep and narrow that will be marked with caution signs warning traffic on road. Follow the road to Case Creek, turn right for 3/4 mile. Camp will be on the left. Route will be signed.

COST TO PARTICIPANTS:

IMO Members: \$15.00 adult, \$5.00 Junior (under 17 years of age)
Non-IMO day membership: \$20.00 adult, \$5.00 junior (under 17 years of age)

TO BRING:

A steed at least three years old. Handheld compass with 2° increments.
Pen or Pencil to mark the map.
People and horse water. Bug repellent. Hat/sunscreen.

Die Hards regret due to Covid 19, we will not be serving a main dish potluck. Please bring your lunch or snacks and a drink of choice. Awards will be given following virus protocols while maintaining social distance.

Note: No horse water in camp, water is available on trail. Ride is mountainous terrain, approx.12 miles.
