

IDAHO MOUNTED ORIENTEERING Little Beaver Creek September 26, 2020



An equine sport that combines riding with map reading & a compass to find five hidden plates on a trail

The ride will be approx. 17 miles long. Camping space is available but tight.

Directions: Take Hwy 21 through Idaho City. Approximately 1.7 miles past Edna Creek turn right on FS 362. (It is a total of 18.4 miles from the Rodeo Grounds in Idaho City to the FS 362 turn.) Travel 1.2 miles to camp.

Registration: 6-8 pm Friday, 7-11:30 Saturday. Riders/teams out Starting at 8:00 AM and then every 15 minutes. Last riders out at 12:00.

RIDE DUES: Adult Annual Members: \$15, Adult Day Members: \$20, All Members 17 years old and under: \$5

What to Bring:

- **Something for Pot Luck (Ride managers provide the main dish)**
- **Steed in good condition and at least 3 years old**
- **A Chair**
- **Water and Bug Spray for you and your steed**
- **Weed free feed is required. Hay and manure need to be scattered**
- **Compass with 2-degree increments**
- **Pen or pencil**
