Directions

From Nampa:

Take Hwy 45 (12th Ave Rd) S to Hwy 45/78 junction; stay to left at the Y. Travel SE on Hwy 78 about 18 mi. One mile after crossing the Sinker Creek bridge, TURN LEFT (E). Travel NE about 2 mi to camp.

From Grandview, this turn is 3 mi N of Fossil Creek OHV parking area

You need to bring

(Chili with fixings will be served for lunch)

Steed 3+ years old

Compass (2° Increments)

Pen or pencil

Rider & Steed WATER

Chair if you wish to sit

First riders out at 8:00 AM, Last riders out at 12:00 noon
