Fly spray

Route is rocky in places.

HOW TO GET THERE:

From Boise/Ontario: From I84, take Exit 33 in Nampa - Marsing Hwy 55 & head SW. Stay on Hwy 55 for approx 17.5 miles (passing through Marsing) to Hwy 95. Go South on Hwy 95 for 23.5 miles. At the "Welcome to Oregon" sign, turn left (S) - you will still be in Idaho. Proceed approx 1/3 mile to camp.

From Mtn Home: Take Hwy 67/167 SW to Grandview. Take Hwy 78 West towards Marsing. Continue 10.6 miles past Hwy 45 turnoff to Birmingham/Sommer Camp Road. Turn left (W). Go about 200 ft to Sommer Camp Road. Turn left (S). Travel 6.5 miles to Hwy 95. Turn left (S). Proceed 17.8 miles to "Welcome to Oregon" sign. Turn left (S) - you will still be in Idaho. Go about 1/3 mile to camp.
