Camp does not have water. The ride is on varied and rocky terrain; shoes / boots are recommended. There are water crossings on the trail.

Ride Dues:

Adult Annual Members: \$15, Adult Day Member: \$20, All Members 17 years old and under: \$5 Exact change or checks are recommended.

Directions:

From Boise or Mountain Home, take Highway 21 to Idaho City. In Idaho City, turn Left on Main Street, then right on Bear Run Road. Follow the signs to camp, it's approximately 2.5 miles.
