# What to bring:

- ✓ Potluck item (optional)
- Horse, mule, or pony in good condition and at least 3 years old
- ✓ A chair
- Water and Bug spray for you and your animal
- ✓ Compass with 2 degree increments
- ✓ Pen or Pencil
- Noxious-weed-free feed for steeds is recommended
- Rake and shovel to clean up hay and manure before leaving

# Ride Notes:

Camp does not have water. The ride is on varied and rocky terrain; shoes or boots are recommended. There are water crossings on the trail.

## Ride Dues:

Adult Annual Members \$15, Adult Day Member \$20, All Members 17 years old and younger are \$5. Exact change or checks are recommended.

#### Directions:

**From Marsing,** From the 55 / 78 intersection head west on ID-55 for 1.9 miles, continue onto US-95 N for 1.9 miles, turn left onto Cemetery Road. Continue on Cemetery Road for 1.0 mile. Turn left onto S. Jump Creek Road for 3.6 miles - Once the pavement ends you will go straight through the gate/cattle crossing (don't go to the right, that's to Jump Creek Recreation area). Follow the signs to camp, approx.1/2 mile.

**From Homedale**, head south approx. 4.5 miles on US-95 from Homedale to W. Thompson Road. Turn Right on W. Thompson Road for 56ft, turn Left onto Jump Creek Road for 4.5 miles - Once the pavement ends you will go straight through the gate/cattle crossing (don't go to the right, that's to Jump Creek Recreation area). Follow the signs to camp, approx.1/2 mile.
