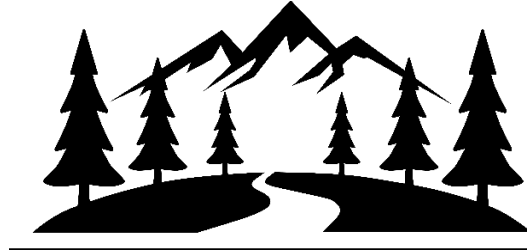


Idaho Mounted Orienteering

3 Creek Ride

Date: Saturday, August 27, 2022

Ride Distance: +/- 13 miles

Registration: Friday: 6:00 pm – 8:00 pm

Saturday 7:00 am – 12:00 noon

First participant times out at 7:00 am then following in 15-minute increments.

What to Bring:

- Something for the Potluck (optional) (Ride managers will provide the main dish)
- Horse, mule or pony in good condition and at least 3 years old
- A Chair
- Water and Bug Spray for you and your Steeds
- Compass with 2-degree increments
- Pen or Pencil
- Certified noxious-weed-free feed for steeds
- Rake and shovel to clean up hay and manure before leaving

Ride Note:

Camp does not have water. The ride is on varied and rocky terrain; shoes / boots are recommended. There are likely water crossings on the trail.

Ride Dues:

Adult Annual Members: \$15, Adult Day Member: \$20, All Members 17 years old and under: \$5
Exact change or checks are recommended.

Directions:

Directions: I-84 to Mountain Home, Hwy 20 to Hill City, (approx. 40 mi.), 2 miles past Hill City turn left onto Vodermeier Rd./1100 S. At the "T" turn right then veer left onto 1200W. Continue to just past the public restroom, turning left onto Chimney Creek Road. Continue down Chimney Creek Road to just past 2nd gate (approx. 4.2 miles). Camp will be up and on the left. CAUTION: Please be prepared that there is a lot of logging in the area and some road spots are extremely soft.
