A timed competitive equine sport that combines riding with map reading, compass use, and clues to find five markers.



Directions: from I-84, take Mountain Home exit 90 (Burger King). Take the first left and go east on Frontage Road 2 miles to stop sign. Turn left, onto Canyon Creek Road, go north 7.2 miles. At fork, turn right and follow road around to right, go east 3 miles. Camp is on right, south of road. Road is dirt, but not bad.

To Bring: A mount at least 3 years old, compass with 2 degree increments. A dish to share at the pot luck. Hat/sun screen/ bug spray. Water for horses (dry camp). Pen or pencil to mark map. Drinks and a lawn chair.
