A timed competitive equine sport using a map, compass and clues to find five hidden markers – **FUN! ADVENTURE! CHALLENGE!** A treasure hunt on horseback!

### **LENGTH OF RIDE**

Competitive Course: about 14 miles (mostly on FS & logging roads)
Short Course: (will find #2 & #3) 8 mi.

### **WHAT TO BRING**

a trusty steed at least 3 yrs old compass with 1° or 2° increments pen or pencil to mark the map certified weed-seed-free hay people water & beverages steed water in case the creek is dry salad or dessert for after-ride potluck (ham & beans provided by ride mgr.)

**<u>DIRECTIONS</u>** From I84: Take Exit 46 (Eagle Rd/Hwy 55); travel N about 6.5 miles to Hwy 44; turn Right. Travel E 1.8 mi. to Hwy 55; turn Left. Travel N on Hwy 55 about 50 miles to Smith's Ferry; turn Left on FS Road 644 [*High Valley Rd.*] (at Cougar Mtn. Lodge). Travel W/S/W on FS Rd 644 2.0 mi. to 644/626 junction. Stay to right/straight at the junction on FS Road 626. Travel ½ mile NW to FS Road 626H; turn Left. Travel NW .7 mile; turn Left into camp. There is plenty off good flat camping and Tripod Creek runs through the meadow. However, it is Labor Day weekend. We suggest coming up early Friday, or even Thursday.
