#### LENGTH OF RIDE:

Regular Course-  
about 18 miles.

Short Course-  
about 9 miles

*Through rolling foothills, some rocky areas, some not so rocky areas. Good shoes are recommended.*



#### DIRECTIONS:

Travel on Hwy 78 to the Oreana turnoff. Turn south. Go straight for about 3.5 miles (past the rock church, past the Triangle/Bachman Grade turnoff). The road makes a sharp curve to the east, crosses a little dip - take the first road that turns south. Go 7.7 miles to camp. The road is gravel, bumpy in spots, but not bad.

Please bring a salad or dessert for the after-ride lunch. Hot Dogs & fixings provided by the ride managers.
