Registration:

- 1. Saturday 19th 8am
- 2. Riders out in 15 minute intervals
- 3. Please be on time for you departure

Ride length: About 14 miles

<u>Directions:</u> Please consult a map prior to traveling to camp.

<u>From Boise</u>: Take blacks creek road exit #64 and turn left onto Blacks creek road. Travel approximately 7 miles to a Y in the road. Hold to the left this is still blacks creek road. Travel approximately 29 miles crossing the south fork of the Boise River at Neal Bridge and continuing to the next Y in the road. Turn left on long gulch road and travel approximately 4 miles to camp Passing the "Y Store" on the right and Strawberry loop road also on the right.

Ride Dues:

- 1. Annual Members \$12
- 2. Day Members \$15
- 17 and younger \$5

What to bring:

- 1. Water for you and your steed.
- 2. Dish of food for a potluck lunch
- Compass, Pencil, and Steed of your choice at least 3 years old

From Mountain Home: Take highway 20 north to the Prairie road. Turn left and travel to the cow creek crossing the river. Continue on to blacks creek road and turn left. Turn right on long gulch road and travel approximately 4 miles to camp Passing the "Y Store" on the right and Strawberry loop road also on the right.
