

Poker Ride On Horseback

SPONSORED BY: Friends of the Weiser River Trail

LOCATION: Wye Trailhead (just north of Tamarack, Idaho, highway 95, about 7 miles south of New Meadows) (see map below for details). **NOTE:** There is a new access road off highway 95. Watch for the signage and ribbons. (This is easier access than last year!) From Boise, either take highway 95 (exit off the Interstate) (by far the best option) or 55 to New Meadows, then south on 95. Fuel, groceries, ice, restaurants, etc. available in New Meadows and Council.

On July 28, 2012, horseback riders are invited to gather at the northern end of the Weiser River Trail for a fun jackpot poker ride! Riders will start at the Wye trailhead and will draw cards at several locations along the trail. High, low and other combination poker hands will win cash prizes. Ride a short course of approximately 7 miles or a longer course of approximately 10 miles.



Riders may register between 10 a.m. and noon, with last rider out at 12:30 p.m., and ride the course at their leisure. Jackpots will be handed out when all riders finish the course.

Registration fee is \$20 per rider and additional hands may be purchased for \$10 each. After the ride, enjoy fresh watermelon, beverages and brownies served by Friends of the Weiser River Trail. All funds raised will go towards trail repairs and maintenance.

Camping overnight is available (and encouraged!) both Friday and Saturday, if you wish to arrive early/depart late and enjoy a weekend of horse camping. Horse and people water available on site. Weed free hay encouraged but not required. Toilet facilities also available on site. Closest restaurants are Pine Ridge at Tamarack to the south and New Meadows to the north.
