- 3) COMPASS, PENCIL AND HORSE AT LEAST 3 YEARS OLD.

DIRECTIONS: Boise go SE on I-84 to Exit 64 turn east on Blacks Creek Rd. and continue to Y stop store (about 42 miles) Turn left on Long Gulch Rd. and go about 5 miles to camp.

From Mtn Home to Prairie about 40 Miles to Y Stop Store. Turn right on Long Gulch Rd. and go about 5 miles to camp.

Long Gulch has lots of space for parking and camping. While it is a relatively close, the feeling is remote and private. This ride takes you into an area that is recovering from a fire 20 years ago. The Camping area has large trees and meadows. Come Friday afternoon or evening and enjoy a really nice weekend camp out.
