BOISE RIDGE RIDE

September 22, 2012



A timed competitive equine sport that combines riding with map reading, compass use, and clues to find five hidden markers.

This last ride of our IMO 2012 season is a journey through perhaps the prettiest and most unexplored region of Idaho. Minimal rock on the trails and gradual elevation changes, and through healthy forest! Come ride this 14.5 mile course and enjoy the beauty of Idaho.

DIRECTIONS

From Boise: Take Highway 55 north to Horseshoe Bend.
From Emmett: Take Highway 52 east to Horseshoe Bend.
On the south side of Horseshoe Bend, at the end of the 4-lane, TURN EAST on Harris Creek Rd. toward Placerville. Go about 13 miles to Harris Creek Summit. TURN NORTH (left) on Hawley Mtn. Rd/FS Rd. 374. Travel 2.5 miles to camp. Parking on both sides of the road, however, it is limited. Not very good camping. If you want to camp, go about 1 mile past Harris Creek summit and park at Huckelberry Flat on your right; haul in Saturday morning.

Bug Spray for steed and rider
Compass (2-degree increments)
Pen or Pencil to mark the map
Something for the potluck
A chair if you wish to sit
