# BANNER CREEK

Mounted Orienteering is a timed competitive equine sport that combines riding with map reading, compass use, direction finding skills and clues to find five hidden plates.

Ride the 13-mile competitive course, or the 6-mile non-competitive course along Forest Service roads and trails.



### PLEASE BRING

Something for the potluck  
*(Ride managers will provide sloppy-joes)*  
Beverage (including water)  
A chair if you wish to sit  
A Trusty Steed at least 3 years old  
**Certified noxious-weed-free feed**  
Compass with 2° increments  
Pen or Pencil to mark the map  
Bug spray for rider & steed  
Water in case the creek is dry

### DIRECTIONS

From I84: Take Exit 57, Hwy 21. Stay on Hwy 21 through Idaho City, over Mores Creek Summit, past Whoop-um-Up Creek Park & Ski (mm56). About .6 mi. past mm56, turn Right onto FS384/Edna Creek Campground/Crooked River Rd. Travel Eastish on 384 about 4.5 mi.. Turn left on FS312 (Pikes Fork, Banner Creek). Travel north about 1.2 mi. to camp at the junction of 312 & 386.
