Enjoy the trees, wildflowers, fresh outdoors, and possibly some wildlife! Camping space available around the area, so come spend a night or two.

Riders out in 15-minute intervals starting Saturday at 8:00 AM

What to Bring:

- + Something for potluck (Taco main course provided by the Ride Managers)
- + A trusty steed at least 3 years old
- + Water for self and steed
- + A chair
- + A compass w/2° increments & pen/pencil

Directions: From Boise: Head north on Hwy 55. About 5 miles past Horseshoe Bend, turn left at Gardena onto Brownlee Rd crossing the river and then turns right for about .5 miles before you take a left to stay on Brownlee Rd. Follow for about 5 miles and go straight onto Cutoff Rd. Follow for a mile and turn right onto Dry Buck Rd. Follow about 6.2 miles and just past the little country church (Pinehurst Church) that sits on the left, take a right onto FS 643 and .3 miles to camp. Watch for sign to camp.

From Emmett: Head east on Hwy 52, and take left/north onto Sweet-Ola Hwy by the Triangle Dinner House. Follow for about 2.5 miles, and take right onto Kirkpatrick Rd. Follow 2 miles to the "Y" in the road (pavement ends), and go right onto Brownlee Rd. Follow 2.5 miles and take left at "Y" onto Dry Buck Rd. Follow about 7.6 miles and just past the little country church (Pinehurst Church) that sits on the left, take a right onto FS 643 and .3 miles to camp. Watch for sign to camp.
