Travel south approximately 4 miles to Victory Lane, turn West (right). Stay on this road to camp (it will take you down into the canyon).

From Boise: Take Meridian Exit south 8 miles to Kuna. Go west through Kuna 6 miles to South Side Boulevard, turn South (left). Go through Melba southward to Base Line Rd. Stay on Base Line east to Can-Ada Road, then south to Victory Lane.

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
