NEED TO BRING: Something for the after-ride potluck
(The main course will be provided by the Ride Managers)
A chair for sitting
Compass with 2° increments
Pen or Pencil
Water for yourself and your steed
A trusty steed at least three years old

DIRECTIONS: Take Highway 78 to Oreana Loop Road at Mile Marker 43. Go 2.2 miles to the old rock church. Turn right onto Bachman Grade Road (Road to Triangle), and go another 8.6 miles to camp.

NOTES: Sections of the trails are very rocky. Shoes or other hoof protection recommended.
