
Idaho Mounted Orienteering

Competitive Course about 14 miles. Non-Competitive Course about 7 miles.

DIRECTIONS

From I84: Take Exit 57, Hwy 21.
Stay on Hwy 21 through Idaho
City, over Mores Creek Summit,
past Whoop-um-Up Creek Park &
Ski at mm56. About .6 mile past
mm 56, turn right on FS384
(Crooked River Rd./Edna Creek
Campground). Stay on 384 for
about 4.5 mi. Turn left on FS312
(Pikes Fork, Banner Creek).
Travel north about 1.2 mi. to camp
at the junction of 312 &386.

Certified noxious-weed-free feed
Water for steed and rider
Bug Spray for steed and rider
Compass with 2-degree
increments
Pen or Pencil to mark the map
Something for the potluck
A chair if you wish to sit

Rake, Shovel, or Fork TO SCATTER MANURE & FILL HOLES BEFORE YOU LEAVE
