184, Exit 46, Hwy 55/Eagle Rd. Travel N on Eagle Rd about 6 mi to Hwy 44. Turn E (right). Travel E on Hwy 44/State St about 1.7 mi to Hwy 55. Turn N (left). Travel N on Hwy 55 about 60.6 mi to Cabarton Rd (at Clear Creek Station). Turn W (left). Travel W & NW on Cabarton Rd about 2.5 mi to FS Rd 446 (by big red barn). Turn W (left); cross the railroad tracks; turn to left. Stay on curvy & occasionally steep Rd 446 for 3.0 miles to FS Rd 421. Turn S (left). Travel on Rd 421 about 1.1 mi to camp.
