DIRECTIONS: Take Hwy 21 through Idaho City past Edna Creek and mm57. Turn right on FS 362 (total 18.4 miles from Idaho City). Go 1.2 miles on 362 to camp on FS 362D2 junction on the left.

Alternative camp if this is taken, look for GOLD on sign on 362 and continue on HWY 21 a few more miles to Gold Fork trailhead/parking on left.
