Graveyard Point Ride

Registration: Friday June 14, 6 - 9 p.m, or Saturday, June 15, 7:00 - 11:00 a.m.

Ride Dues: \$20.00 Adult Day Membership, \$15.00 Adult Annual members, \$ 5.00 riders 17 and under

Riders timed out in 15 minute intervals from 7:30 - 12:00 on Saturday

What to Bring:

1. Trusty steed at least 3 years old
2. Water for you and your Steed (Certified weed-free hay)
3. Compass (2 degree)/ Pen or Pencil
4. Dish for potluck , Main dish will be provided.
5. Chairs

Terrain can be rocky so shoes or boots are recommended.

Ride is approximately 14 miles.

Directions: From Marsing, travel west toward Homedale on HWY 55/95 to Graveyard Point Rd. Between mile marker 31 and 32, turn left (west) on Graveyard Point Rd go about 4 miles to Sage rd. Turn left on Sage rd, go about .9 of a mile to Nielson In. Turn right onto Nielson and go about .7 miles to camp. Follow the signs

From Homedale take Hwy 95 toward Marsing to Graveyard Point Rd. Turn right (west) on Graveyard Point Rd. go about 4 miles to Sage rd. Turn left on Sage rd, go about .9 of a mile to Nielson In. Turn right onto Nielson and go about .7 miles to camp. Follow the signs.
