Directions:

HWY 21 to Idaho City. Turn N (right) on Montgomery St. or Main St. Travel N to the High School/Elementary School. Turn W (left) on FS rd.307/Centerville Rd. Travel approximately 7.5 miles to the junction of FS 307 and FS 382/Grimes Pass Rd. Turn N (right) on FS 382. Travel N on FS 382 toward Centerville and Pioneerville for approximately 3.5 miles to the IMO sign. Turn W (left). After passing through the gate (which may be closed, but the chain just clips shut), the road gets narrow but is passable. Parking is ample but not spacious. This site is a mining claim, so do not use any mining equipment or metal detectors, don't collect any minerals, be respectful of the property and do not disturb their equipment. Pick up and carry away all hay and manure.
